ACTA MEDICA SALINIANA IN 2010: CONTINUOUS DEVELOPMENT AND GROWTH

Another year is behind us and it is our distinct pleasure to be able to inform you that Acta Medica Saliniana continues to grow. During the last year, more than 15315 visitors coming from 126 different countries have visited our web site. Almost 50000 separate page views were recorded during that particular time.

We have had more than 60 separate submissions, with the acceptance rate of the peer reviewed manuscripts of around 60%. The average time to finished review was 88 days, while average time to publication was 121 days.

We have managed to upgrade our online journal system and to make significant design improvements. It is also our pleasure to have Acta Medica Saliniana added to Scopus indexation service. One of the most important improvements is that our Journal is member of CrossRef system and each of our papers will have a Digital Object Identifier (DOI). It is not an exaggeration to state that our Journal is currently the fastest growing medical journal in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

It is our plan to expand furthermore; we are probably going to increase the frequency to 3 or perhaps 4 issues per year. We also plan to improve the content of the journal and to continue with our efforts to have it indexed in major indexation services.

However it would be very hard to accomplish such a task without the help of our authors and people who spent their time to review manuscripts for us. It is our duty and pleasure to list the names of those taking active role in the peer review process in the last year.
